### Community

Upper Bucks Christian School is a private Christian school in the Southeast corner of Pennsylvania. It is located about 30 miles north of Philadelphia and about 20 miles south of Allentown. Upper Bucks ministers to students from various school districts including Central Bucks, North Penn, Palisades, Pennridge, Perkiomen Valley, Quakertown, Souderton, Southern Lehigh, and Upper Perkiomen. Upper Bucks also ministers to students from various countries including China, South Korea, Spain, and Vietnam.

### School

Upper Bucks is a comprehensive 4 year Christian school that currently has about 45 students in grades 9-12. The school has been in existence for 50 years and offers programs for students from K to 12<sup>th</sup> grade with a current K-12 enrollment of about 150 students.

### Curriculum

The High School academic program at Upper Bucks Christian is based on yearly credits. Students are expected to take an average of 6.25 credits per year, and four year students should have 25 credits to graduate. Students may take up to 8 credits per year.

AP® courses are offered in English Language and Composition and AB Calculus. AP is an open-enrollment program.

Honors classes are offered in English, History, Math, Science, and Bible for grades 9-12.

Additional College Prep courses offered include Advanced Math, Algebra II, Biology II, Chemistry, and Physics.

GPA Calculation: Beginning with the 9<sup>th</sup> grade, all subjects are included in this computation. Grades are recorded on the transcript, and GPA is computed at the end of each school year. AP courses receive an additional 1.0 and Honors courses receive an additional 0.5 on the GPA.

### Graduation Requirements

Students who attend Upper Bucks all four years of high school must have 25 credits to graduate, including 4 Bible, 4 English, 3 History, 3 Mathematics, and 3 Science credits.
