MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT SUPPLIES

The following is a list of supplies which are needed by each middle school student. The purpose of the supply list is to allow parents the opportunity of purchasing the needed supplies for their children before school begins. Please note that there may be an additional item(s) to obtain during the school year, per the teacher's request.

Book covers: Please do not purchase the self-adhesive style. Be sure not to tape book covers directly to the hard back of the book.

BIBLE: All students will need a **ESV Bible** for normal bible class.

BIBLE QUIZ — **KJV Bible** - Old and New Testaments (A Bible with concordance & cross reference is recommended.)

PE CLOTHES (Grades 5th-8th): All 5th-8th grade students at UBCS will be required to have PE clothes. Non-marking athletic shoes are required footwear (no slip-ons). Loose-fitting t-shirts (not white) and loose-fitting shorts that cover the knee are acceptable girls' clothing. T-shirts and shorts or play pants are acceptable boys' clothing. (*UBCS PE Shirt is not required.*)

FIFTH GRADE: Put your name on binders/notebooks.

- 4 sturdy, PLASTIC pocket folders with holes
 - 3-ring binder (put folders in binder)
 - 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
 - (12) wooden #2 Pencils
 - Small Zippered Pencil Pouch
 - 1 highlighter
 - 2 soft pink erasers
 - 2 glue sticks
 - 1 composition books (wide ruled)
 - 3 x 5 cards (1 pack of 100)
 - 3 large boxes of tissues
 - 1 container of Antibacterial Wipes
 - PE bag (draw-string variety is recommended).
- PLEASE: NO PENS, MARKERS, ETC.**

Fifth Grade ART: 1 set of 3 sharpie metallic markers (gold, bronze, silver)

Students with last name A-M: 1 pack of (25-50 sheets) black card stock (approx. 8 ½ x 11)

Students with last name N-Z: 1 pack of (25-50) sheets black card stock (approx. **12 x 12**) (if you can't get 12 x 12, please get a size you are able like 8 ½ x 11 or larger)

Please be sure to put your name is on each item when you hand it in to your art teacher on the first day of school!

SIXTH GRADE

- 5 pocket folders
- 3 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- Math scratch pad
- Several red pens
- Several #2 pencils
- 1 colored pen (NOT red) for Reading class
- Small zipper pencil pouch
- 2 composition books
- 4 x 6 notecards & 3 x 5 notecards
- Report cover for English
- A basic 4-function calculator designed for elementary school use
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- One container of Antibacterial Wipes

Sixth Grade ART: 1 wooden tray or flat wooden frame for mosaic project & 1 pack fo long thin wires for sculpture project- floral wire works well.

Students with last name A-M: 1 pack of (25-50 sheets) black card stock (approx. 8 ½ x 11)

Students with last name N-Z: 1 pack of (25-50) sheets black card stock (approx. **12 x 12**) (if you can't get 12 x 12, please get a size you are able like 8 ½ x 11 or larger)

Please be sure to put your name is on each item when you hand it in to yourart teacher on the first day of school!

SEVENTH & EIGHTH GRADES

- 3-ring notebook(s) for 8 1/2" X 11" notebook paper (avoid those with worldly themes portrayed on them.)
- Notebook dividers with paper or a notebook for notes – **see below for specific class requirements**
- Pens (blue or black ink)
- Several #2 pencils
- 2 tissue boxes & 1 container of Antibacterial wipes for homeroom
- **English:** a composition notebook/journal & a report cover, folders for class papers, 8.5 x 11 notebook paper (required daily), blue/black pen and a colored pen (*not red*)
- **Life Science (7th) & Earth/Space Science (8th):** 2 notebooks: a homework composition notebook and a notebook/paper for note taking
Red pen (for all MATH classes)

MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT SUPPLIES cont.

- **Fundamentals of MATH:** TI-30 (or better) calculator
 - Pocket folder, spiral notebook, and big pink eraser
- **Pre-Algebra:** TI-30 (or better) calculator is *recommended* as well as...
 - Pocket folder, Dry-erase markers, Mechanical pencils. A good eraser
- **Algebra I:** TI-30 Scientific or better Texas Instrument calculator (or other approved calculator) as well as...
 - Pocket folder, Dry-erase markers, Mechanical pencils. A good eraser
- **History:** journal/notebook for writing assignments
- **Bible:** 3X5 spiral index cards
- **Seventh Grade Art-**
 - 1 pocket folder for notes and handouts
 - 1 black calligraphy marker (2.5 nib size)
 - 1 kneadable eraser
 - 1 pad of nice quality watercolor paper
- **Eighth Grade Art-**
 - 1 pocket folder for notes and handouts
 - 1 medium range pencil set 4H-6B (Derwent is highly recommended brand – avoid Artist loft or Walmart brand)
 - 1 kneadable eraser
 - 1 pad of smooth Bristol Board (8 ½ x 11 or larger)
 - 1 sketch book- optional-you may bring a used one OR draw sketches on plain paper to be kept in a folder
