ELEMENTARY STUDENT SUPPLIES

The following is a list of supplies which are needed by each elementary student. The purpose of the supply list is to allow parents the opportunity of purchasing the needed supplies for their children before school begins. Please note that there may be an additional item(s) to obtain during the school year, per the teacher's request.

Water Bottle: Please bring a personal reusable water bottle (plastic disposable can be used.) Please put your child's name on any bottles he/she will bring to school.

Personal Sanitizer Bottles: Recommended types contain 70% alcohol. Please put your child's name on the bottle.

Wipes: 2 containers of wipes (Lysol or Clorox or any anti-viral version). Please put your child's name on the containers.

Tissues: 3 Boxes

Box of Plastic Utensils- Forks/Spoons-To be used at lunch or with projects in class.

Book covers: Please do not purchase the self-adhesive style. Be sure not to tape book covers directly to the hard back of the book.

KINDERGARTEN

- ESV Bible for class (not NKJV)-*text edition 2016, not 2007*
- 1 small school box
- 2 boxes of crayons (box of 24 – no larger), twistables preferred, **individually labeled**
- 2 bottles of Elmer's glue (the "washable", "no-run", or "gel" glues are not recommended.)
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 Crayola 10-pack washable kids' paint set
- 1 Crayola 10-pack markers
- 10 yellow #2 pencils
- 1 pair of scissors with plastic handles and metal blades (Fiskars work well)
- 1 soft pink eraser
- 2 sturdy PLASTIC folders with bottom pockets on the inside

- 1 notepad (with wide lines)
- 2 small-tip EXPO (dry-erase) marker (black or blue)
- Small old sock (to be used as an eraser on individual white boards)
- Lunch box labeled with name
- Backpack (large enough to fit folder and lunch box but small enough for the student to handle)
- *Rest mat for nap time – if you do not have one from our Daycare program, we will issue one to your child (the mat fee is \$15)*

FIRST GRADE

- ESV Bible for class (not NKJV) *text edition 2016, not 2007*
- Crayons (box of 24)-twistables are suggested
- Regular white Elmer's glue (blue label-medium or large) ****not "no run" or "gel"****
- 8 glue sticks
- 1 large box of size #2 pencils, sharpened
- 1 soft pink eraser
- Small pencil box (6 x 9 or smaller)
- Lunch box (labeled with name)

- 5 sturdy plastic folders (with pockets on bottom)
--1 of each color: red/green/blue & 2 other colors
 - 1 three-ring binder
 - Book bag or Backpack (labeled with name and large enough for a notebook)
 - Scissors-plastic handle, metal blades (**Fiskar** preferred)
- *PLEASE - No pens, markers, or colored pencils**
***Everything must be labeled with the child's name**

SECOND GRADE

- ESV Bible for class (not NKJV)- *text edition 2016, not 2007*
- 2 boxes of #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) sharpened
- 1 soft pink eraser
- Crayons (box of 24) – NO twistables
- 2 highlighters
- 3 sturdy plastic pocket folders (1-red, 1-blue, 1- other)
- Pencil box (plastic only)
- 3 glue sticks-no white glue

- 1 wide ruled spiral notebook (70 pages)
 - Scissors
 - Ruler with Centimeters
 - 1 box of Colored pencils (8 to 12-count)
 - 2 small-tip Expo (dry-erase) markers (black or blue)
 - Small old sock (to be used as an eraser on individual white boards)
 - Lunch box
 - Backpack
- *PLEASE - No pens or markers

THIRD GRADE

- 2 sturdy pocket folders (1-red, 1-blue)
- #2 pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- Scissors
- 1 highlighter

 - Twistable crayons/colored pencils
 - 3 soft pink erasers
 - 1 composition book (wide-rule required)
 - 2 Small-tip black dry-erase markers
- *PLEASE - No pens or markers,

FOURTH GRADE

- ESV Bible for class (not NKJV) *text edition 2016, not 2007*
- 4 pocket folders (red,blue,green,other)
- 1 Composition book for homework
- 1 70-page spiral notebook (wide-ruled)
- #2 pencils
- 1 container of scotch tape
- Small zippered pencil holder (bag or box)

- 2 red pens
 - 1 Glue stick
 - 1 50-pack of 3 x 5 ruled- spiral bound index cards
 - Scissors
 - 1 12-pack of colored pencils
 - 4-pack fine or chisel, black or blue dry-erase markers
- *Everything must be labeled with the child's name.**

MUSIC (1st – 4th Grades)

All students 1st-4th need to have a pair of earbuds, labeled with their name in a ziplock bag (with their name on the bag as well). These will be kept in the music room and given to the kids when they need them. At the end of the year they will be returned to the students.

PE CLOTHES (Grades Kind-4th)

We are not requiring any special attire for PE. The students will participate in PE with their normal school clothes. This will help give more time for PE class.

ART

K- 1 pack of white card stock/ 1 medium or large size bottle of GLOSSY Modge Podge

1st- 1 set of 16 Crayola water colors/ 1 pad of tracing paper.

2nd- 1 jar of rubber cement / 1 set of 2 (or more) of EXTRA fine tip Sharpie black markers

3rd- 1 set of 2 (or more) of FINE tip (NOT extra fine tip) black Sharpie markers/ 1 triple pack of metals fine tip sharpie markers (bronze, silver and gold)

4th- 1 box of 12 assorted OIL pastels (Preferably Sargent Art brand or another high-quality brand) / 1 pad of charcoal paper
